Anti-corruption is higher on the corporate agenda than ever before, following the recent passage of the Bribery Act in the UK, and a growing number of high-profile legal cases and regulatory investigations. Companies now need to ensure that they have 'adequate procedures' in place to prevent bribery. Anti-corruption systems need to be robust and thoroughly implemented, and regularly updated, reviewed and refreshed.

As the regulatory climate evolves and consumer awareness grows, companies simply cannot afford to ignore the damage caused by direct or indirect involvement in bribery. It leads to loss of reputation and brand, as well as legal penalties including substantial fines and imprisonment for executives. If companies are perceived by stakeholders to be complicit with corrupt regimes or involved in unethical business or political relationships, the damage can be profound and the business can take years to recover its reputation and market position.

Operating successfully without exposing a company or its employees to bribery can be complex and difficult, but addressing the challenge can also bring huge benefits. By reducing potential risks related to bribery and corruption, companies can reduce the costs of doing business, drive competitive advantage, and help to attract the best investors and employees.

Services

Training

We can work with your company to scope, design, and deliver anti-corruption training for employees.

We can provide introductory training covering core concepts such as assessing corruption risk, recognising bribery, facilitation payments, gifts and hospitality, and dealing with agents and

intermediaries. Introductory courses would typically last for one day, though longer and shorter sessions can also be designed. They would include presentations, discussion and interactive scenarios.

We can also provide more advanced training suitable for compliance professionals, or for employees working in specific industries, countries or high risk job functions (such as sales and marketing or procurement). Such sessions would be designed with the company to address its unique needs and challenges. If required, TI-UK can 'train the trainers', provide content for in-house training courses and materials, and attend training courses as an expert third party.

Benchmarking

We can review your company's anti-bribery systems and provide a report detailing our assessment of any gaps between the company's systems and TI's view of best practice, with recommendations for improvement. This exercise would be undertaken by expert consultants on a confidential basis, and based on practical application of our benchmarking tools. Both limited reviews and comprehensive assessments can be conducted as appropriate. The service includes both a review of policies and processes, and detailed interviews of staff in various functional roles and levels of seniority to test the overall implementation and understanding of anti-corruption systems.

This work would be carefully scoped following initial discussions, but would typically require a team of 2-3 experts to spend several days with your company, ideally accompanied by a member of your own senior staff with responsibility for compliance and governance functions.
